PROGRAM CONTENT

The Climatetech prorgam runs for 4 months and requires a commitment of 5 to 8 hours per week. It offers a combination of collective workshops and individual work sessions for entrepreneurs to provide comprehensive support. In addition, entrepreneurs have the opportunity to meet with mentors, experienced CEOs, or specialized members of the management team. The program includes three diagnostic sessions conducted by an entrepreneur in residence and a committee of experts.

Most sessions of the program follow a similar structure: a short collective session led by an expert to bring all participants to the same level, followed by individual in-depth sessions with the expert.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

In addition to the guidance, participating in Cycle Momentum's Climate Tech Acceleration Program grants access to:

- Experts in supply chain, financing strategies, market entry strategies, pricing strategies, and storytelling.
- A 360° evaluation of your company at key moments (beginning, middle, end) during the program, conducted by our Entrepreneurs in Residence (EiRs) and experts to highlight the strengths and weaknesses of your startup and help adjust the program accordingly.
- Quantification of potential greenhouse gas emissions avoided by your startup's solution, following ISO-14064-2 standards.
- An established network of clients and partners.
- Dedicated funding programs.
- Funding opportunities through the Circle of Partner Funds.
- A "Green Light" event to present your solution to our partner investors.
- Free membership to Écotech Québec's clean technology industrial cluster.





WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR:

Entrepreneur: Committed to your project full-time and ready to be fully involved in the program. One member of the management team (CEO or co-founder) must be available between the months of September and February to participate in the program, requiring approximately 5 to 8 hours of involvement per week (sessions or preparatory work). Sessions will be conducted in a hybrid format, but we will gradually increase in-person activities to maximize outcomes.

<u>Impact</u>: Your solution has a significant and measurable impact on the environment.

<u>Business Model</u>: Your business model is economically viable and has a high potential for return on investment. The target market is accessible and of significant size.

<u>Technology</u>: You have a high-tech solution or product that addresses a real problem and the teampossess unique and defensible ownership rights.

<u>Stage</u>: Seed and early-stage. You must demonstrate commercial traction and/or have a prototype.

NEXT STEPS:

1. Preselection based on applications

After receipt of applications, an initial selection will be made. The applications will be evaluated on the basis of the evaluation criteria.

2Interviews preselected candidates.

During the week of September 4, if needed, we will schedule an interview to learn more about you, your team, and your company, as well as the product, market, and competitive landscape.

3. Presentation before a selection committee

The preselected candidates will be invited to give a presentation and participate in a question-and-answer session during the week of September 10th.
