Introduction

In partnership with Bioenterprise Corporation, Agtech Zone and Cycle Momentum invites you to apply for the 2023 Cycle Momentum Acceleration Program: Agtech – powered by the Agtech Zone. The Agtech Accelerator Program is 100% dedicated to the commercialization of innovative agricultural technologies in Quebec. The program aims to accelerate companies that propose concrete solutions to reduce the environmental footprint, help agricultural producers adapt to climate change and/or develop food autonomy in Quebec.

As part of the program, five seed-stage companies proposing innovative agricultural solutions will be selected and receive mentoring and advice from industry experts to grow their companies.

The selected companies will benefit from:

- 16 weeks of intensive coaching as part of Cycle Momentum's Accelerator Program, which is known for its strength in scaling ClimateTech startups (+90% survival rate over 5 years);
- 90 hours of strategic coaching² over 3 years, offered by industry experts (value of \$13,500);
- Up to \$250,000 in loan financing for eligible businesses;
- Access to Cycle Momentum's Partner Fund Circle (30 venture capital partners), Desjardins, Fondaction and other funding partners of the Agtech Zone; ⁴
- An ecosystem that is dedicated to scaling agtech companies. The Agentech Accelerator network
 consists of 2,500 agricultural producers, 100 startups in agtech and plant bioproducts; 30 partner
 research and innovation centres, 20 major agricultural, agri-food and agro-industrial companies
 and multiple strategic partners, including five international corridors.
- Direct support and introductions to the Quebec Agtech Community



4. Selection Criteria

We are looking for companies that can:

- Develop a product or service that addresses a real market problem and/or offers a solution to improve efficiencies in the agriculture sector;
- Demonstrate that the product or service has attractive growth potential;
- Showcase sufficient and achievable market size.

This means that:

- Your product or service must be at a maturity level of TRL-7 and above;
- The initial problem/solution fit must have been validated;
- You must have established contacts with potential customers in the sales pipeline;
- You should have started testing your business model with customers and gathered early insights to develop your product further.

Agtech Acceleration Program

5. Eligibility

Your solution must aim to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in Quebec;

- Relocate to the Agtech Zone within 18 months after the start of the program to take full advantage of the Agtech ecosystem and connect with industrial partners and investors to showcase your product and solution;
- The executive team must consist of at least two people.

6. Timeline


- Application Deadline: December 13, 2022, noon;

- Program Participation Fee is \$750 (following your selection);
- Participation in the program's activities are compulsory and will take place every Monday and Thursday from February 2023 to early June 2023.
